

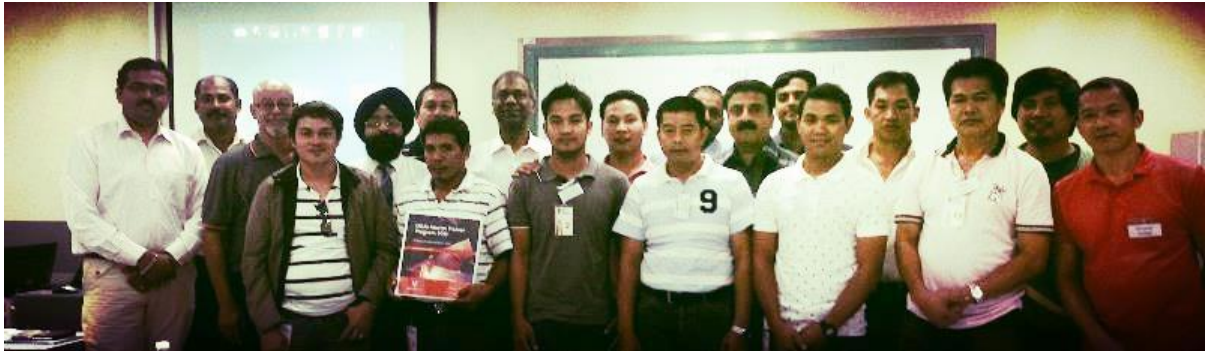

OGM/VETASSESS Master Training Program Delivered

The first [OGM/VETASSESS](#) Master Training Program was held from 14 to 30 November in Manila, Philippines. The training program was attended by 16 Master Trainers from our 4 partner institutions. This is the first part of the 12 months Training and Development program of the [OGM](#) and partner institutions Master Trainers with mentoring of the Master Trainers, starting in January, 2014.

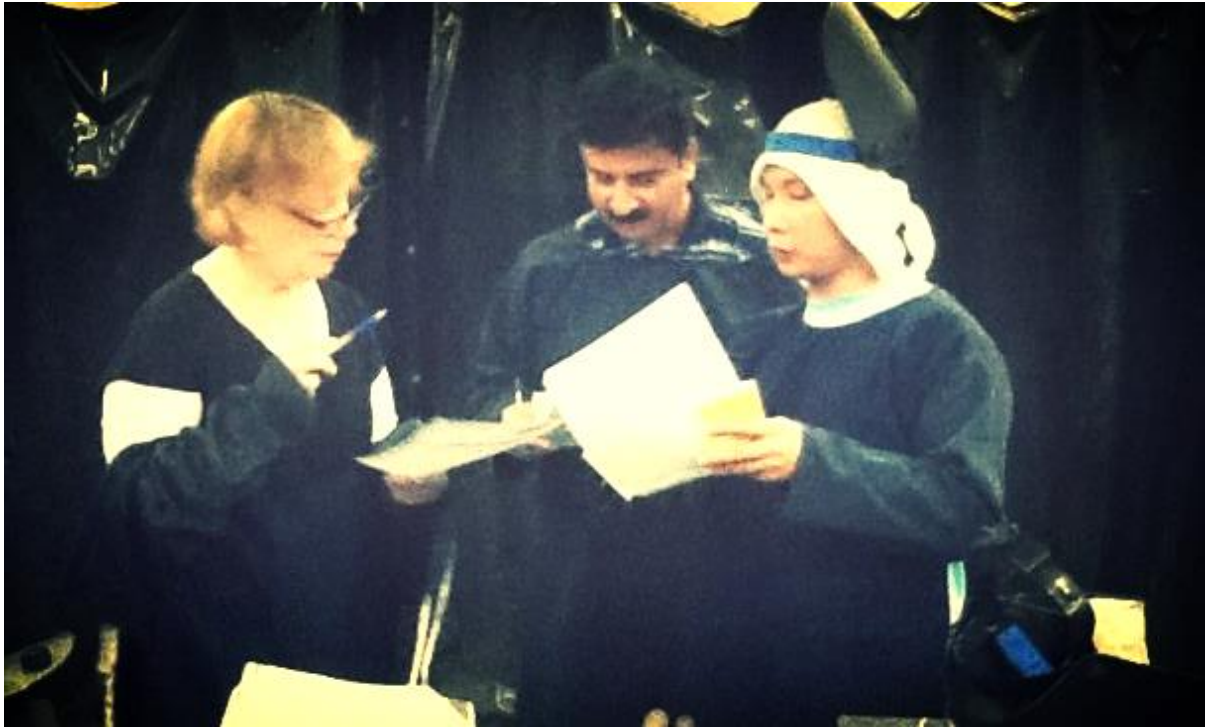


Group photograph of participants, VETASSESS Trainer and Senior Managers from our partners

The intensive training program covered the following topics:

1. The Australian National Training Framework
2. What is Competency
3. Assessing Competency
4. Adult Learners
5. The Learning Context
6. Learning Sessions – How to Plan and Deliver
7. Designing Learning Programs

Trainers from our delivery partner [VETASSESS](#), delivered the Master Training Program using a combination of both theory and practical sessions. The practical sessions, included how to plan assessment activities, conduct and validate assessments; presentation and delivery techniques; and planning, preparing and delivering learning sessions. This provided the opportunity for all our Master Trainers to practice what they had learnt as well as be assessed to ensure that they met the required competency requirements to become Master Trainers.

The training program also included a 2-day Occupational Health & Safety (OH&S) program to ensure that all our Master Trainers are only across the OH&S requirements but also have the latest knowledge in this very important area. They all went through numerous practical exercises to ensure that they can, not only teach the students all the required safety practices but also apply them at their institutions, some of which are starting such courses for the very first time.
